

# Annual Pinner Wheelbarrow Race 3.00 pm

Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2018

**\*\*\* WHEELBARROW PARADE\*\*\***

To highlight the tradition of the wheelbarrow race, a parade of contestants (dismounted) with their wheelbarrows will take place down the High Street (which is closed to traffic) at 2pm. Afterwards, walk up Bridge Street to Little Common for the briefing at 2.40pm as usual.

A prize for the race winner and best dressed team will be awarded IMMEDIATELY after the race.

## The Parade :

Meet 2.00pm at Church Farm Green at the top of the High Street (where the race finishes)  
**2.15pm** the Parade down the High Street.

## The Route :

Little Common– Elm Park Road– Bridge Street Gardens– High Street– Church Farm Green

## The Six Stops :

Start- Oddfellows Arms- Bridge St Gardens- Victory- Queens Head- Church Farm Green

## The Rules

1. There must be two people in each team. (Fancy dress optional – but strongly **encouraged!**)
2. The teams must use standard single-wheeled wheelbarrows, which are in good working condition. Any decoration must not impair handling.
3. One team member must be sitting in the wheelbarrow and the other team member must push the wheelbarrow and colleague unassisted. At no time must the wheelbarrow move forward without the passenger seated.
4. Both team members must drink a complete half a pint of beer at each stop.
5. Teams must only cross the roads at stewarded crossing points.
6. Teams must go round the Dragon anticlockwise at the top of the High Street, en route to the finish line at Church Farm Green to the left of the High Street.
7. The finish point on the Green is where the final half pint is to be drunk to finish the race
8. All monies raised will be donated to local charities.
9. All team members enter the race at their own risk.
10. Teams must hand completed application by 6.00 pm. on Friday **20<sup>th</sup> April 2018**, to The Queens Head or Oddfellows Arms or Beer Asylum or email [jeremy.foster@ramboll.co.uk](mailto:jeremy.foster@ramboll.co.uk)
11. Stewards will be in attendance at designated stops and at road crossing points. The winners will be confirmed once the stewards have reported that an honest race has been run by them.
12. We encourage fancy dress and decoration of wheelbarrows, names of teams etc.
13. A maximum of 20 teams will be allowed to compete. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.
14. An entry fee of £5 per person will be payable (in named envelope pinned to application or brought to the start of the race). This will contribute to the cost of running the race.

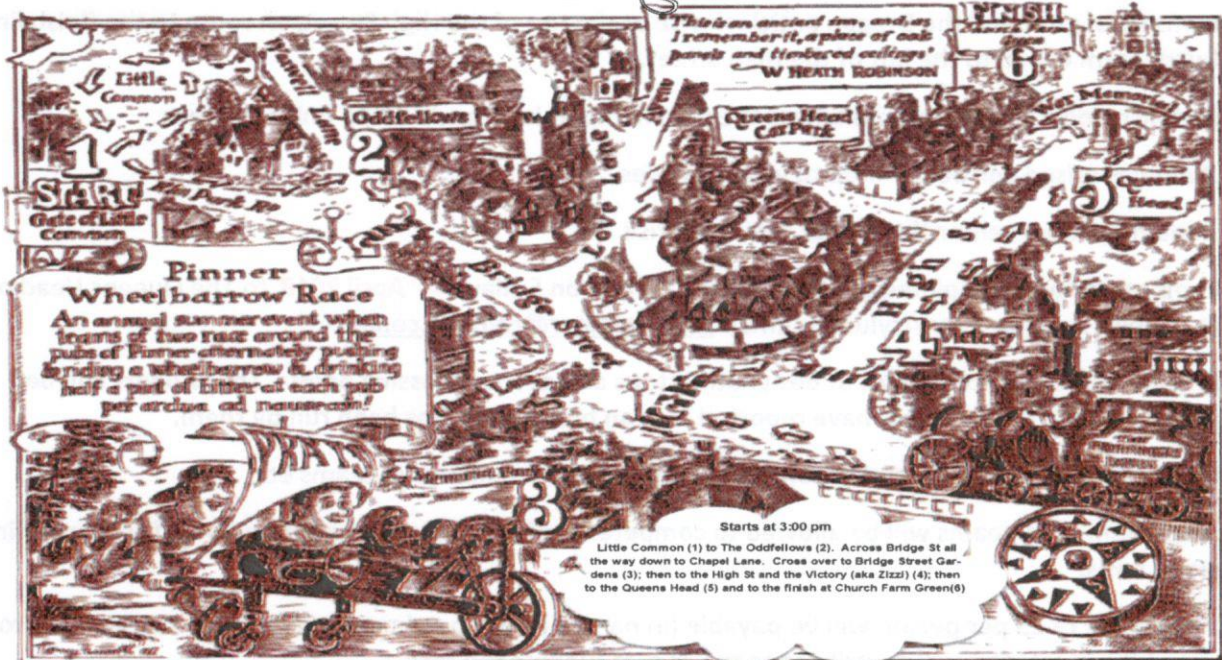
